YEAR 6 VISIT TO BLACKLAND FARM

- We would like to offer a residential visit to **Blackland Farm** for our Year 6 pupils.
- The trip will be organised by '**TrekCo**' which is a well established Outdoor Pursuits company, employing only qualified staff. The Trekking Company will take responsibility for organising and supervising all of the adventurous activities on the programme.
- The range of activities available may include; canoeing, rock climbing, climbing wall, abseiling, scrambling, orienteering and swimming.
- The trip will take place from **Wednesday 10th July to Friday 12th July 2019**.
- We shall travel by coach, leaving the school on Wednesday morning and returning to the school Friday afternoon.
- The cost of the trip will be **£194** per pupil.
- To make the cost of the trip more manageable for parents we have organised a payment scheme that will operate as follows:
- A non-refundable deposit of **£30** per pupil will be required by **Friday 11th January**.
- The remaining **£164** will be payable in **4 monthly** instalments of **£41** from **February - May 2019**. (Only the deposit is required in January).
- Instalments of **£41** will be due by the following dates:
Thursday 28th February, Friday 29th March, Friday 26th April and final payment is due by **Friday 24th May 2019**.
- To pay for this trip the school encourages parents to pay using our **Parent Pay** system. No Cash or Cheques will be accepted.
- If you are interested in your child taking part then please complete and return the attached **reply slip together with your deposit and completed medical form** to the school office by **Friday 11th January**.
