Dear Parents/Carers,

Rosen Class will be assessed on **Monday 3rd June 2019** to ensure they are able to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres. Mrs Smith will contact you if your child would benefit with additional swimming lessons.

These will take place at the Sovereign Centre swimming pool. Swimming is a compulsory part of the PE curriculum and this is a really exciting opportunity for the children to develop their skills. This is especially important as we are in close proximity to the sea.

The class will have 1 session and the time which we have been allocated is 9:30 – 10:30am.

Mini Bus Transport will be provided to and from the Sovereign Centre Pool. For this, the children will be split in to two groups. Mrs Smith and a support staff member will also be present while the children are travelling to the Sovereign Centre and during swimming sessions. The children will be supervised at all times during the morning. The children will be taught by a specialist swimming teacher at the Sovereign Centre.

No money will be needed for lockers, but please ensure your child brings the following equipment for their swimming sessions in a named bag:

- Swimming goggles
- A towel
- Boys: close-fitting swimming trunks rather than baggy swimming shorts
- Girls: a one-piece swimming costume

Your child will be back at school in time for lunch.
